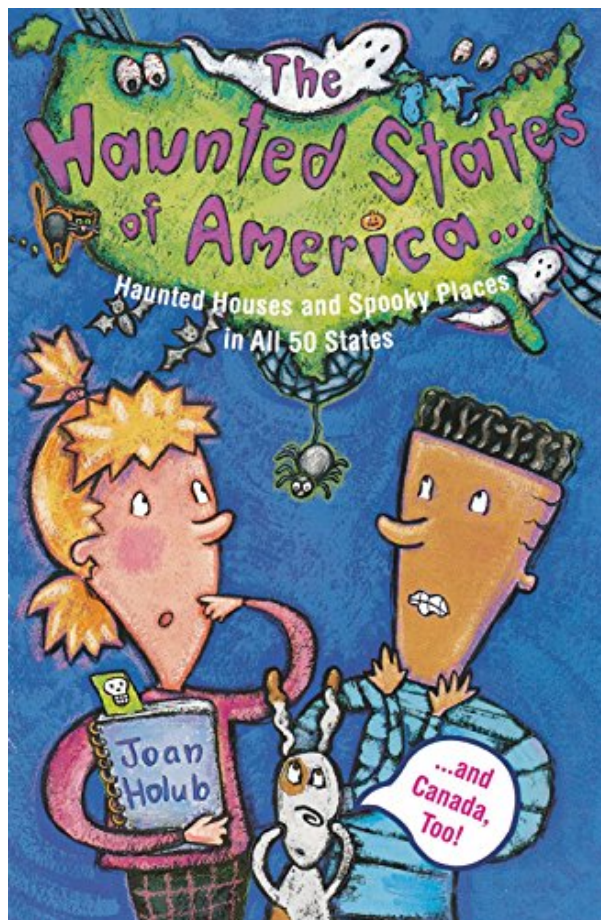
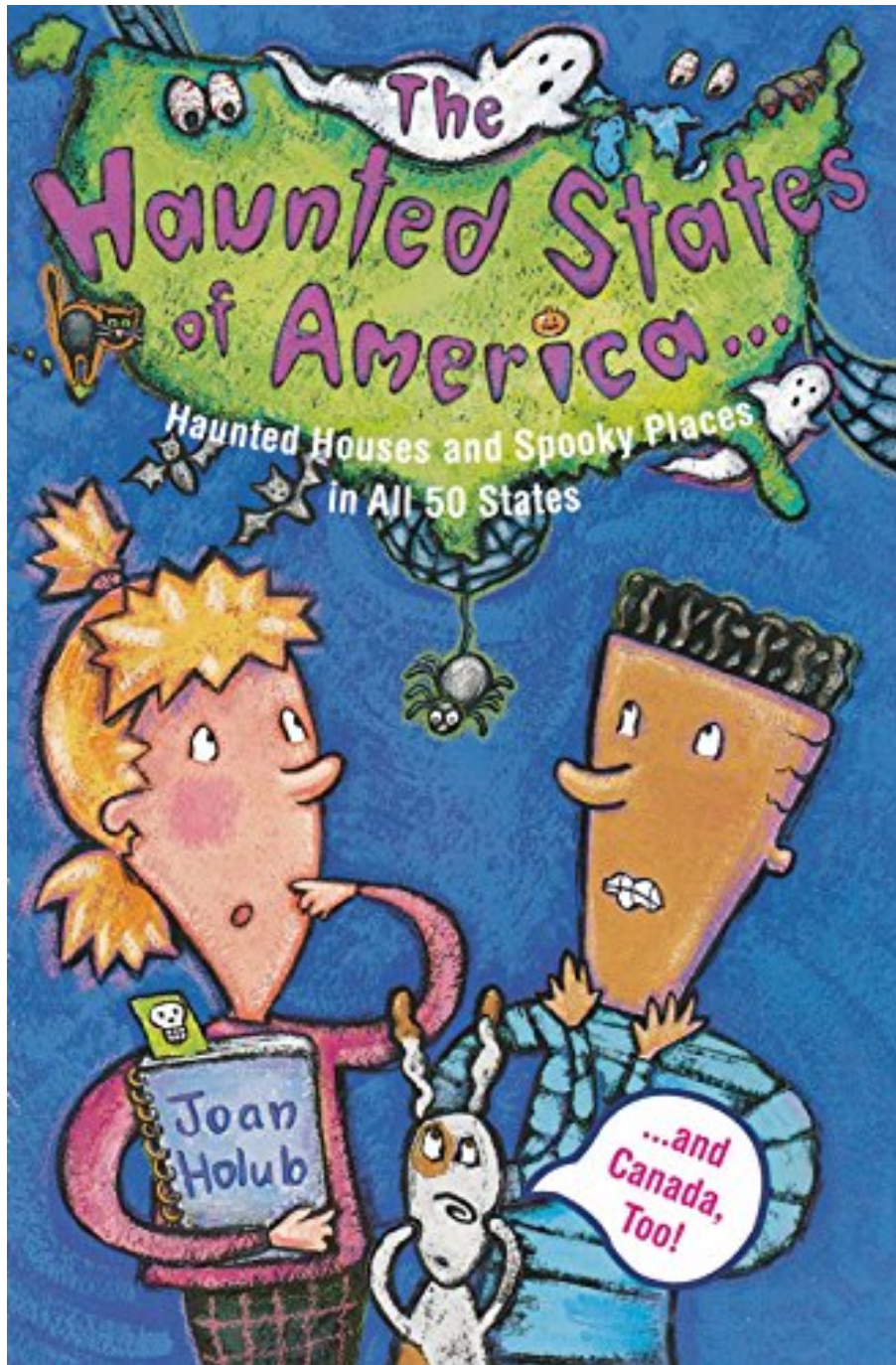

Every delicious chapter of "*The Haunted States of America*" draws the reader into a creepy world of apparitions and strange phenomena that may (or may not) exist among us, in places we can easily pinpoint on the map, or maybe even visit. With the shivers and thrills densely packed into an average of two or three pages per chapter, even reluctant readers may find themselves up past their bedtimes, unable to resist the temptation to read just a little bit more.

The engaging style and the variety among different kinds of stories make this book well worth reading, but I would have enjoyed a few more pictures. While the wide scope of the book will appeal to casual readers just looking to enjoy a scary story, those with a more serious interest in history, folklore, or parapsychology may prefer to seek out a work of less breadth and deeper focus.
